Holiday Fund Summary:

Joel expressed thanks to the membership. Background - 2 years ago members could “opt out” and collected \$50,000. Last year tried “opt in” and didn’t get very much money.

This year returned to “opt out” and received tremendous support. We have 1600 membership and over 100 members gave \$100 or more. One member gave \$500. Therefore, this amounts to being able to give every hourly employee \$300+. 100% of the funds collected go to the hourly employees. Last day to “opt out” is 12/9/2020. Kingsmill will get checks to employees before Christmas. This year collected so far \$50,000 and have 60% less employees than we did 2 years ago; hence the employees this year can receive more per person.
