

Star Wars

An annual fun team competition

The Star Wars tournament is played in October and is one of the highlights of our season!

- The format for the Star Wars Tournament is a Modified Ryder/Solheim Cup Format. (6 holes are played as a two-person team alternate shot; 6 holes are played as team best ball and 6 holes are played as individual match play.)
- It is played on a pre-specified day and KM course
- Players earn points by playing in the weekly KPGA18s competitions. Additional points are given to players who win 1st, 2nd or 3rd place for the week. One point for playing, 3 points for a first place, 2 points for second place and 1 point for third place. In team events, only participation points are awarded.
- Players earn the right to participate on the two, 8-player teams by accumulating points throughout the KPGA season.
- The teams will be determined after the last play day in September. The 16 players with the most points* will make the two teams. Every effort will be made to keep players on the same teams as previous years. Pairings for the competition will be made by the Star Wars Chairperson based on similar handicaps.
- The team that earns the most points on the day of the tournament wins STAR WARS and will have their names engraved on The Star Wars plaque. The plaque is hung in the ladies' locker room.
- Players **earn** their participation onto the Star Wars teams and every participant earns a \$\$ payout at the end of the competition year.

* If any of the top 16 players is not available on the competition date, the next person on the list will be chosen. This process will take place until 16 players are available. In the event of one or more players with the same year-end points vying for 1 position, a random drawing will take place.
