

## KLGA Executive Board Meeting Minutes 1/27/21

The Executive board meeting of Kingsmill Ladies Golf Association was called to order on ZOOM by president Debbie Argy at 10:00am. Attending were Debbie Argy, President; Gaby Fellows, 1st Vice President; Mimi Taylor, 2nd Vice President; Mary Carlson, Secretary; Ronnie Matthews, Treasurer; Karen Levy, Ex-Officio Board Member.

Debbie welcomed everyone. Debbie announced her goal for the year was to get more women into KLGA golf and to create an open and cohesive association. She hopes to expand Karen Levy's theme on "The Mental Game".

Gaby Fellows, 1st Vice President:

Debbie asked Gaby to review the bulletin board in the locker room making space for new information, such as new member information and what the 9 and 18 hole groups stand for. Gabby cleaned up the board, along with the help of Jan Ivy. They put new rules in the middle bulletin board. They also took time to rearrange the furniture to make it more cozy. Gaby said the large corner wooden unit serves no purpose other than taking up space and would like it removed. She is looking for the coffee table that used to be in the room. She would also like to start a Golf Book Lending Library to be used out of the ladies locker room. Gaby discussed a new survey that she and Debbie are working on. It is a questionnaire about the usage of the KLGA website, usage of the locker room space, and interest in other golf opportunities. Gaby plans to send out the questionnaire in early February, asking it to be completed and returned in a week. She will then collate the results and share them with the members. Gaby discussed golf opportunities, i.e. Invitationals and possible Home and Away events. She will post these on the bulletin board and on the KLGA website. She will be working with Landon at Kingsmill to update the website and help members access it.

Ronnie Matthews, Treasurer:

Ronnie reviewed the 2021 budget. The carry over from last year is \$4019.53. Since we have fewer members, the cushion for next year may be smaller. Ronnie discussed each line item and where we might cut costs. The bottom line budget for 2021 is \$10,620.

Mimi Taylor, 2nd Vice President:

Mimi discussed the Proposed 2021 playing schedule. She talked about having competition on the Gold/Green tees. After the survey results are known, she'll have a better idea how the membership feels about using the combo tees. The Club Championship will be one week later, the first week of October. A second Bring-A-Friend day was added. Star Wars will continue, and Mimi will send out publicity about it at a later date.

The Executive Board meeting was adjourned at 11am, prior to the Zoom meeting with all committee chairmen.
